Discipline Reports

Down The Line report by Norrie Scott

Thank you to all Lads and Lassies of the DTL fraternity for an unbelievable season for our discipline. There is no denying Scotland has talented DTL shooters culminating with the greatest success in our sport for 43 years. We will expand on this achievement further into the story of 2025.

This season began with the knowledge that Glenmoriston shooting ground was hosting the home international and British championships. This resulted in some excellent turnouts for 100 bird shoots and the scores generated were outstanding. These scores developed confidence across all disciplines which became evident in a very competitive Scottish Championship.

For the first time the Scottish championship was held independently from the ground which holds the home international. North Ayrshire Shooting Ground delivered a great event with some excellent scores being achieved. Both days generated close battles resulting with the senior championship being decided in a shoot-off between David Taylor and David Galloway Jnr.

Congratulations went to David Taylor well deserved for his consistency throughout the season. However, kudos also to David Galloway shooting a brilliant maximum 100 – 300 at this same ground a few weeks earlier. Accolades go to all winners including Gail Barclay Ladies champ, Cailean Maclean Junior champ, David Taylor Veteran champ and Jim Presly Super vets champ.



As intimated earlier the honour of holding the home international and British championships landed at Glenmoriston shooting ground. This brought challenges which required a huge push in a short time scale to increase the number of traps, to plan and develop all the detail required to hold such an event.

Lads and Lassies you know the outcome, the greatest two days of competition between the home nations whereupon for the first time in 43 years Scotland seniors captained by Ivar Mcbay won the coveted Nobel industries DTL international challenge cup by two points from England. This was an incredible achievement as the quality of shooting from several competitors hit maximum 100 x 300 scores. The word to describe all the effort from the start to the end is simply, BRILLIANT.



A huge vote of thanks goes to the many volunteers and sponsors who delivered the effort to create the kind of welcome to our home countries our country would be proud of. BOY o BOY did that happen. It is human nature to find something to complain about and not one shooter from any association passed any derogatory comments about the shoots or the welcome which the beauty of the Highlands gave them.

Reviewing the 2025 DTL season was exciting in many respects however there are external issues to the SCTA in our sport which need to be addressed. Whilst we must recognise these issues, we need to ensure we build on the achievements of last year.

The management of DTL within the SCTA unlike any others is within our control. Moving forward into 2026 we must see a DTL rep in place supported by an efficient team manager and when appointed, a team Captain. This will allow a DTL strategy and plan to try and repeat the historic win of 2025 expanding similar progress across the other DTL categories.

Growth and positive change require purposeful effort—not luck or waiting.

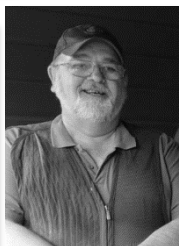
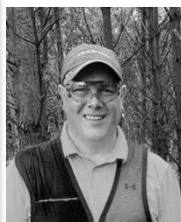

You will be automatically eligible for any prizes and trophies in the category and class you have entered. You will still be eligible for the main competition trophies and prize monies in addition to any trophy for which you may be eligible in your category. You will be required to ensure any trophies won and are bound to return them to the SCTA prior to the next year's Championship. Due to the SCTA having no Colts category under 16's are eligible for both Colt and Junior trophies.

Entries will be **taken on the day** at all Scottish Championships; however, once the allocation of places has been filled **entries will be closed, this may be before the day of the Championship**. You are advised to pre-enter to ensure that you are allowed to compete. Entry should be made by email to the host ground unless otherwise specified. Email addresses of host grounds can be found at the back of the bulletin.

For NSP, DTL and NSK you will be asked to declare if you intend on going for Team Selection on entry to the relevant Scottish Championship. Any members who do not declare their intention on entry to the Scottish championship will not be considered for team selection.

For all disciplines with a Home International the SCTA will pay 50% of the entry fee less the prize money contribution to the hosting ground for any Junior SCTA members.



Scottish Team Selection Procedure and rules

It is the policy of the SCTA to promote a performance-based selection procedure. Everyone who competes in a selection shoot is a potential team member. There is no requirement to submit a team selection form for any discipline.

Shooters scores and ranking place will be shown in the SCTA database Team Selection table for the relevant discipline. A marked-up points system will be used for the Sporting discipline. Providing shooters satisfy all selection criteria and general conditions decided by the Management Board of the SCTA or a properly constituted Selection Committee they will be considered for Selection.

***For the avoidance of doubt the SCTA defer to the CPSA General and Technical Rules for all selection shoots unless these rules are contradicted by either the current bulletin, existing policies shown on our website or official correspondence from the current board. In the case of OTR and OSK disciplines ISSF rules will apply unless these are superseded by any of the above.**

It is the shooter's responsibility to ensure they comply with the General conditions of eligibility and eligible scores and all other requirements as laid down by the SCTA.

General conditions

If a shooter does not have enough scores they will not qualify. If a shooter does not have an area championship score, they will not qualify. If a shooter does not compete in the relevant Scottish Championship they will not qualify. If a shooter does not want to be considered for team selection, they should inform the relevant discipline representative. Members must abide by all discipline specific rules.

The Management Board's decision is final in all selection matters as detailed in section 3 and 4 of the By-laws.

Membership and Eligibility for Team Selection:

Only fully paid-up members of the SCTA are eligible for Team places. Membership starts on the 5th January, and membership renewal should be paid before that date. For existing or lapsed members their membership renewal must be received before the 1st March of the current year for the shooter to be eligible for selection. Membership renewal payments will be accepted up until the 1st March, however scores from selection shoots after the 31st December till the date the membership fee is paid will not count towards team selection.

New members may join the SCTA at any time during the year and if they comply with all other requirements, they will be eligible for Scottish Team selection.

The Management Board reserve the right to refuse a team place to any member who, by

previous conduct, is considered by the board to be unsuitable to represent Scotland. The Management Board also reserve the right to select shooters by invitation to make teams up to full numbers or as near as possible full numbers, on recommendation of the relevant discipline selection committee. A discipline selection committee should consist of Management Board members, discipline representatives, team managers, and if possible, team Captains.

International team Dress Code:

Shooting in practice or at the international event, you are required to wear a Scotland Shooting vest. Other than the jacket manufacturer's, the only badges allowed are your name above the breast pocket, a Scotland Team badge on the breast pocket, discipline flashes and year flashes. A blue or white Scotland Shooting Team polo shirt will be required as advised by the team manager, depending on how many days the international is shot over.

ISSF disciplines must comply with the ISSF clothing rules applying at the time.

Trousers, tailored shorts or a Kilt can be worn while shooting but in the case of the latter it must be worn with the correct accompanying accessories. A shirt or jersey with long or short sleeves, not sleeveless and a normal shooting hat. Hearing and eye protection MUST be worn.

For the Team photographs and prize giving banquet, dark blue blazer with Scotland blazer badge, grey trousers, dark socks, black shoes, white shirt with a Scotland Team member tie. Ladies may opt for either a grey or tartan skirt or grey trousers, variances in tartans are acceptable. Ladies may wear a Scotland team member cravat.

New caps will receive a subsidy of £50 towards their first Scotland shooting jacket on application in writing to the Association Treasurer. No patterned camouflage wear or equipment of any sort is permitted. The SCTA has a range of clothing available to order from a link on the website.

Scottish Team Categories

If a shooter does not wish to compete in their default category, then they must inform the discipline rep/administrator in writing one month **before** the Scottish Championship, which category they wish to be considered for. It is the responsibility of the shooter to advise any requested change in category. If no request has been made the default categories will be applied.

For example, a Lady can opt to shoot in the senior team, a Lady Junior may opt to shoot in the Junior and not Lady category, a Veteran may opt to shoot in the Senior category etc. The relevant number of qualifying scores for that category must be attained to be considered.

Once this choice has been made, that shooter will be judged against the other competitors in that category for a team place. If that shooter does not qualify in the chosen category, then that shooter MAY be offered a different category place if there is a place available and their scores qualify them.

Senior (OPEN) teams. There are no gender rules or age limits on shooters for the Senior (Open) Team.

Junior teams. A member must be **under the age of 21 on the 1st January** in the year of the International to qualify as a Junior. Proof of age is required; other age restrictions apply for Eire and Northern Ireland.

Veteran teams. A member must be **over the age of 55 on 1st January** in the year of the international to qualify as a Veteran. Proof of age required.

Super Veterans Team: A member must be **over the age of 65 on 1st January** in the year of the international to qualify as a Super Veteran. Proof of age required

Ladies Teams.

To qualify for the Ladies category a person must be of female gender at birth or be a male to female transsexual. Individuals who have undergone gender reassignment after puberty are eligible for participation in their acquired gender providing that they have lived fully in the acquired gender for at least two years. The individual will be required to provide original documentation or certified copies to be held by the SCTA of the following:

A. Written confirmation from the individual's GP that all required surgical anatomical changes have been completed two years prior to the application and that hormonal therapy has been administered for a sufficient length of time to minimise any gender related advantages whilst clay target shooting. **B.** The Gender Recognition Certificate. **C.** The revised Birth Certificate if available.

The above requirements are in accordance with the policy on transsexual competitors issued by the International Olympic Committee and also conform with the recommendations set out in the UK Sport guidance booklet "Transsexual People and Sport" published by the Department for Culture, Media and Sport.

Eligibility

To be eligible for the Scottish team each member must comply with at least one of the following criteria:

- i. Having been born in Scotland.
- ii. For a parent or grandparent to be, or have been, a Scottish national.
- iii. To be married to a Scottish national.
- iv. Having been officially resident in Scotland for a minimum continual period of one year prior to qualification.

Ties for team places

Ties for team and reserve positions will be resolved by a shoot-off under the relevant discipline rules at the relevant Scottish Championship. Any shoot-off for these places must take place as soon as the results are known.

Team Manager

The position of team manager will be decided by the board. Should you be interested in the role of team manager for any of the disciplines please register your interest with the administrator before 1st March. It is permissible for all disciplines except DTL that the Team Manager can also be a Team Member.

Team Captain

The position of Captain of each Scottish Team will be offered to the team member with the highest score following the completion of the selection procedure (scores for competitions of more than 100 targets will be averaged). Should the shooter decline, it will be offered to the next eligible shooter until the vacancy is filled.

Any ties will be decided by a shoot-off in accordance with the rules applying to team places as previously outlined.

In order to be eligible for Team Captain shooters must be a minimum of 18 years of age on the 1st of January of the year of the Home International and have previously represented Scotland.

DTL Captain(s)

The Overall Scottish Team Captain will be the Captain of the Senior Team. The Overall DTL Captaincy will be awarded on a cap basis. Members do not accrue caps for overall DTL Captain until they reach the age of 21. Should the shooter decline, it will be offered to the next eligible shooter until the vacancy is filled.

Scores from other ICTSC affiliated bodies and Events outside Scotland:

For all disciplines apart from NSP and FITASC members may take a maximum of **two** scores from other ICTSC affiliated bodies for Team Selection. For NSP and FITASC disciplines no scores from out with Scotland are permitted.

Members may take **one** score from a **registered** shoot from other ICTSC affiliated bodies for Team Selection. The registered shoot must be a minimum of 100 targets. Scores should be available in the public domain and sent to the administrator within 21 days of the competition.

Members may take up to **two** scores from a **GB Selection Shoot, Grand Prix, British Open, Home Country Championship (not Home International) or from a selection shoot** held by any recognised clay target governing body. These shoots should be open and not invitation only. If a member takes two shoots from the list above, they are **not** eligible to also take a score from a registered shoot. If a member is unsure if a score qualifies then they should contact the Administrator for confirmation.

It will be the responsibility of the competitor to provide the Association via the administrator or discipline rep proof of their score achieved at such an event along this can be in paper form verified by an official from the host ground or association or in electronic form provided the results of the competition are in the public domain (i.e., website or internet). The results can be posted by surface mail or by e-mail but must be received by the administrator within 21 days.

Carry forward scores:

A maximum of 2 scores (1 score for NSP) can be carried forward from shoots held between the Scottish Championship in the preceding year and 31st December. Otherwise, all the required scores must be obtained between 1st January and before the allotted cutoff date before the relevant Scottish Championship, (see membership and eligibility) this being the end of the open selection period. Where scores are obtained from a 2-day shoot of 200 targets or more, which takes place between the Scottish Championship and 31st December in the preceding year then no further scores may be carried forward. No scores from FITASC may be carried forward.

Members who are Permanently Resident Out with Scotland (MPROS):

An MPROS may use a maximum of 3 scores from registered or selection shoots obtained from at least 2 different grounds in their country of residence. (If such scores are used then rules outlined above apply) Failing this the scores in question will be disregarded. MPROS must use a SCTA membership number at shoots out with Scotland if they intend the score to be used for team selection. An MPROS member must shoot one area championship as part of their selection score. Although ineligible to take area champion they may win high gun. MPROS do not have a designated Scottish area allocated to them and their membership card will reflect this as 'O'.

2 Day shoots: Where a shoot is held over 2 days, the 2 days scores cannot be split if a competitor completes both days. If for any reason a competitor only completes 1 day, then the first day CANNOT be used but the second day CAN be used. Where a 2-day shoot is of less than 200 targets (e.g., Olympic disciplines) the calculated percentage score will be used.)

Scottish Championship

Members must compete in and complete the requisite number of shoots, including the relevant Scottish Championship. If the Scottish Championship is a 2-day competition, then all categories must compete and complete in both days' competition.

Area Championships

At least 1 (one) Area Championship/Mainland Compulsory MUST be included in the required number of shoots. This applies to all disciplines and all categories i.e., Senior, Lady, Junior, Veteran and Super Veteran.

COMPULSORY AREA CHAMPIONSHIPS EXPLAINED

As a part of the Scottish Team Selection Procedure shooters are required to shoot in at least one compulsory Area Championship. Once a compulsory shoot score has been obtained this will be reflected in our database, for team league placement the highest score attained at an Area Championship will be used for team ranking, any other Area Championship score attained will still be used for Team selection, but these scores will become ordinary selection scores.

In addition to the four normal Area Championships the Management Board of the SCTA felt it was necessary to accommodate those members who live on the outlying Islands to stay engaged in the team selection process without the need to travel to the mainland on a certain date and as such we have provided these clubs the opportunity to hold one (1) Island Compulsory shoot in each discipline.

All SCTA members can shoot at an Island compulsory shoot, but their score will be classed as an ordinary selection shoot. Only an Islander may use their score as a compulsory Area shoot. This ensures that everyone can only gain a benefit from an equal number of area compulsories (4). If a shooter who shoots both a compulsory Island shoot and a South Area Championship only the score from the Island compulsory shoot can be used as a team ranking score although the score from the South Area can still be used as an ordinary selection score. When the North Area Championship falls to an Island ground a Mainland Compulsory will be substituted in place of the North Area to allow an equal number of area shoots for all members.

Dispensation

The requirement to compete in the relevant Scottish Championship may be waived at the discretion of the Management Board on receipt of a request in writing at least 14 days prior to the Championship (unless circumstances prevent this). This dispensation will only be granted after consideration by the Management Board for occasions such as a family bereavement, or if they have been selected to shoot in a clashing International, or if they are representing GB in a team event, or on production of a medical certificate, or other extenuating circumstances.

The Board reserves the right to request proof of extenuating circumstances. Should a dispensation be granted the shooter will have to shoot a nominated competition as an alternative Championship and have the score witnessed. The nominated competition will be subject to prior SCTA Management Board approval.

Team Expenses

Following a financial review and in a bid to not raise membership fees the SCTA board will be making individual expenses voluntary. Should you require team expenses (£100 mainland, £150 overseas) please send an email from the email address registered to your membership to the SCTA treasurer on qualification of a team place, a BACS transfer will then be made the week of the relevant HCIT. Joint requests and those made on behalf of another member will not be considered.

It is the management boards hope that in introducing voluntary expenses scheme we will be able to offer more financial assistance to junior members and new caps in future years and keep membership costs low for all members to benefit.

Number of shoots from any One Ground:

ABT, OT, OS, NSK, DTL- a maximum of 3 (three) scores from any one ground inclusive of an area championship.

FITASC and NSP- disciplines a maximum of 2 (two) scores from any one ground inclusive of an area championship.

Prize Money

At all SCTA shoots the organiser must clearly display both the entry fee for Birds only and Prize money entry. The amount of money paid out per shooter should be equal to the difference between the two entry fees.

Prize money, having allowed for any payment to the High Gun, should be paid out to the classes from which it is collected. Prize money for selection shoots is £5, £1 to HG and £4 to class prizes.

A copy of the distribution of prize monies must be posted on or near the scoreboard before the completion of the day's competition. Birds only entries are eligible to win area championship badges.

Classification System Explained

Classifications are calculated and issued/reissued twice a year. New issues come into effect on the 1st of June and the 1st of December. The SCTA uses the same percentage cut-off points as the CPSA.

The SCTA uses one score in the time period to move up a class and three scores in the time period to move down a class as minimums. If a member hasn't shot more than three registered shoots in any one discipline then their classification will stay the same although their percentage may drop.

When a member has done multiple shoots in the time period the draft also takes into account raw averages and adjusted averages. The adjusted average drops any wayward scores. Any scores 10% (5% for DTL and NSK) below your raw average are discarded and a new average is calculated based on the remaining scores.

Scratching

Whilst the SCTA board appreciates there are times when a member may not be able to complete a competition, scratching is discouraged.

More than two scratched scores in any one classification period may result in a members highest selection score for that period being discounted from selection.

SGC Certificate

Except for Junior members not yet in possession of a Shotgun Certificate all members competing in Scottish Championships should be prepared to produce their SGC at the request of the ground/administrator.

Advertised shoot fixtures are subject to occasional changes from the dates shown below. The SCTA board would suggest all members book accommodation that offer a cancellation policy. Changes to advertised shoot fixtures will be made available on our website and Facebook page.

Social Media / Cyber Bullying Policy

The purpose of this policy is to provide guidelines for the protection of the health, safety and well-being of all members of the Governing Bodies constituting the ICTSC (CPSA, ICPSA, SCTA, UCPSA and WCTA) and all those who participate in the activities organised by these bodies.

1. Social media, for the purpose of this policy, should broadly be understood to include, but not confined to, Facebook, Twitter, blogs, chat rooms, electronic newsletters, message boards, microblogs, online forums, wikis, and other social networking sites and services that permit users to share information with others in a contemporaneous manner.
2. Social media in all its forms is now so easily accessible the opportunity to both post and receive improper comments and statements has dramatically increased. Bullying and harassment in all forms is considered by the ICTSC to be unacceptable.
3. Messages or statements made using social media are often instantaneous and, whilst a useful medium to promote our sport, improper use thereof to post inappropriate messages is a form of bullying. Cyber bullying has the potential to cause great anxiety and distress to the recipient. Cyberbullying can be considered a criminal offence under several different laws within each jurisdiction of ICTSC members.
4. Frustration at a referee, another competitor, club official, coach, visitor or governing body should never be communicated via social media, but rather by way of reasoned, logical verbal and/or written statements through the proper channels.
5. The ICTSC acknowledges the emergence of new technologies and constantly evolving communication mediums and wishes to enable such new media to be used to benefit the sport and its participants. The benefits can be instantaneous due to the immediate nature of social media communication to an appropriate audience using all available social media forums. However, participants within the sport need to be mindful of key points whilst using this immediate form of communication that could possibly lead to its inappropriate use. Remember once comments are made and/or published they are, and remain, in the public forum for a long time and are difficult, or impossible, to retract – once published you lose control of your comments.
6. In the light of the above please consider very carefully before you circulate anything which may contravene the actual, or the spirit, of the ICTSC Social Media Policy. Be respectful to others when making any statement on social media and be aware that you are personally responsible for all communications which will be published on the internet for anyone to see which may then result in legal proceedings being initiated against you by an individual. Action may also result under your Governing Bodies Complaints Procedure or Disciplinary Code of Conduct.

Any resultant action will fall under the ICTSC Amity Agreement.

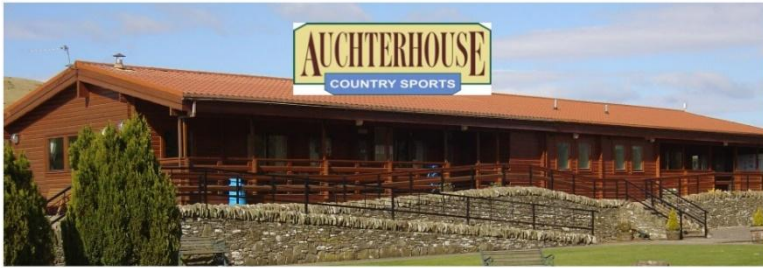
